



**SAFETY RULES FOR ALL TRUCK DRIVERS HAVING ACCESS
TO THE TERMINAL TERMONT MONTRÉAL INC.**

In order to improve the Health & Safety of all occupants on the terminal, please follow the Health & Safety rules at any time.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) on the terminal at all time:

- Safety hat on the terminal (not mandatory in vehicles).
- Safety shoes/boots.
- Reflective vest.
- Pants are mandatory.

Vehicles and traffic rules:

- Respect the speed limit, traffic flow and stop signs in the yard **and pedestrian walkways**.
- Use East and West ends of the terminal to make a U-Turn.
- Do not use a cell phone while driving.
- Make sure you have your hazardous material placard (TDG) **BEFORE** you enter the terminal.
- Do not lock and unlock your securing pins on your trailer when you're in the yard. Please, unlock them before the entrance gate of the terminal and lock them at the exit gate where you open the empty container's doors.
- All equipment that handles containers in the yard (transtainers, Fronts and Stackers) has priority on the terminal. Wait your turn; do not drive against the traffic's direction.
- When you receive a container from a Transtainer, after checking, if your container is not in the right block, please ask a checker to find your container.

A safe and preventive driving is compulsory on the terminal. The non compliance with these safety rules will lead to the following consequences:

- 1st offence: verbal warning
- 2nd offence: verbal warning + dispatcher will be informed
- 3rd offence: verbal warning including refused access for 1 month
- 4th offence: refused access for 1 year
- 5th offence: lifetime ban
