Object: RFID tag Project – Detection of tags at Termont terminal entrances

To the attention of transport companies

Dear Partners,

We wish to inform you that as **of Tuesday January 21st, 2025**, the detection of tags will be monitored on the trucks passing through the entrance (ingate / stage 2) of our terminals Maisonneuve (Section 68) and Viau (Section 52).

From that date, Termont raises awareness of non-compliant truck drivers by giving them a written notice asking them to inform or deliver the notice to their dispatcher or supervisor. A follow-up will be done with the latter to discuss an action plan to take corrective measures to ensure compliance with this measure.

In addition, to assist these companies in accelerating the compliance of their truck fleet, they will receive an automated email containing detailed data for each non-compliant visit.

Starting on February 3rd, 2025, a truck driver without a tag could be denied access to our terminals. As information, **tags are mandatory** on all trucks operating in our terminals since **September 3rd, 2024**.

Termont considers the implementation of RFID tags as an essential element to improve the security of all stakeholders on our terminals. We are confident that this measure will contribute to a more efficient and secure supply chain that benefits all community members.
